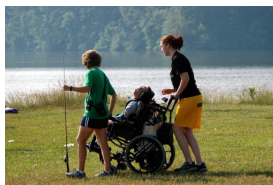

What does it really cost to... **SEND A KID TO KAMP?**



Everywhere you go everyone is talking about the economy and what it means to them. Well here at Kamp Dovetail we aren't any different. Yes it is that wonderful time of year again for Kamp Dovetail. But the economic situation has unfortunately made an impact here as well. Last year the volunteer staff, board, Linda and many of the volunteers have come up with ways to tighten the belt and cut out things while still keeping the Kamp Dovetail experience alive. Some examples of change include Kamp ending early so one dinner was not served. Kampers did not make lanyards, or swim on Friday, and volunteers only received the Kamp T-shirt if they paid for them. There were additional cost cutting measures that happened with every activity, but the volunteers and staff worked hard to be creative and maintain the overall feeling of Kamp. Unfortunately, the economic situation has not improved this year.

The board considered having to make cuts again this year but decided to maintain the current expenses and continue efforts to cover costs. The cash cost based on last year's financial statement was \$278 per camper. This cost is after the \$20 registration fee and does not include the cost of training the volunteers. Even though the fundraising events have not significantly increased in amounts raised, the board determined that the plan to cover these expenses was reasonable and no individual campers would be cut from the program.

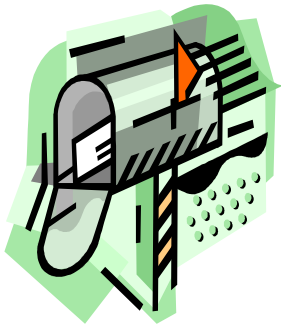
